In accordance with CIL Regulation 59A, Sutton Courtenay Parish Council, being a Council without a Neighbourhood Plan has received 15% of revenue from the CIL chargeable development that has taken place in the parish since the adoption of the CIL charging schedule by the Vale of White Horse District Council on 27th September, 2017.
