Matters arising

Chairman's Report

The Chairman had provided copies of his report with the agenda pack. The highlights of the report were as follows:-

Over 45 planning applications had been considered and comments submitted to the District Council. At the time of writing, Council are strongly contesting the Hobbyhorse Lane housing development application: the public meeting with the developers left the latter in no doubt as to the level of opposition in the village and the HIF Didcot to Culham link road and flyover which will have a serious impact on Sutton Courtenay and the neighbouring villages. Five parishes, Sutton Courtenay, Appleford, Nuneham Courtenay, Clifton Hampden and Culham have come together to mount a robust response with professional help from an array of experts in various aspects of planning. Radcot Green still looms.

Work on the neighbourhood plan continues.

Council are currently working on the refurbishment of the recreation ground, opening the next phase of the cemetery, and the Arts Trail.

Accounts

The Parish Council's audited accounts for the year ended 31st March 2021 were presented. The accounts for the year ended 31st March 2022 had not been finalised but would be published on the website in due course.
